The S130/190 Red Card course is offered twice each spring by the State of Alaska, Division of Forestry, Mat-Su Area Office. One class is held in March at the Chugiak Fire Department and the other one is held in Palmer at the State Forestry Office. The class is one week long and free of charge. Each class will have no more than 40 students and attendance is mandatory.

This application does not guarantee acceptance into the class. Applicants will be called and/or emailed by March 2017 in the order applications are received. If you do not respond to our attempt to contact you, you will not have a place in the class. If you are accepted into the class, you will receive a course schedule and additional information.

Upon completion of the class and the work capacity test (pack test or fitness run), you will have a Red Card with the qualification "Firefighter 2". This will allow you to work as a wildland firefighter. A fireline safety refresher class and work capacity test will be required on a yearly basis in order to maintain any wildland fire qualification.
